Lower branches are being cleared for safety.

The five year capital plan includes new equipment for maintenance greens. Assessing is taking place regarding the irrigation system. New irrigation systems are more specific but the cost is high.

Ladies' Thursday evening golf regularly had more than 50 attendees and 80 attended the final scramble and dinner.

Paving around the cart shed will not occur, instead a salt solution will be used to minimize the dust.

The overflow lot will be planted with grass.

More trees will be moved during the winter.

Paving of cart paths will be ongoing.
